Covid 19 Risk Assessment

Outbreak Management Plan

<p>Hall Cross Academy will continue to follow National and Local guidance in relation to Covid 19. In the event of increase community transmission (direct or Indirect) advise will be taken from DfE, Public Health or Doncaster Council who may advise any of the following activities / tasks.</p>	
<p>Restricting Attendance</p>	<p>This will only be done after full consultation with DfE, Public Health and Doncaster Council.</p> <p>Attendance restrictions should not be used to address operation issues including staff shortages.</p> <p>High Quality remote education will be implemented.</p> <p>Where it is appropriate to increase attendance DfE will advise which groups should be prioritised for return.</p>
<p>Asymptomatic Testing of Staff</p>	<p>If directed, staff may be asked to increase asymptomatic testing at home.</p>
<p>Face Coverings</p>	<p>In the event of an outbreak, it may be necessary to reintroduce face coverings in the academy. If this is necessary, face coverings should be worn in communal areas where social distancing cannot be maintained.</p>
<p>Reintroduction of bubbles and social distancing</p>	<p>It may be necessary to reintroduce bubbles in order to resume social distancing and limit the transmission of coronavirus.</p> <p>This may include staggered start / finish / break times ensuring that students maintain their full educational entitlement.</p> <p>The academy will adhere to any conditions set out by the local Public Health Team.</p>
<p>Trips and Visits</p>	<p>Any attendance restrictions will be reflected in the risk assessment and the leaders should consider if the educational visit is still appropriate and safe.</p>
<p>Staff Workforce</p>	<p>Staff will be updated of any actions advised by DfE / Public health / Doncaster Council and Risk Assessments will be updated to reflect and protective measure put in place.</p> <p>Government Guidance on critically extremely vulnerable people will continue to be consulted and followed.</p>
<p>Parental / visitor attendance</p>	<p>The Academy may be advised to limit attendance of other adults in the setting. Parents / non-essential visitors will be advised .</p>
<p>Safeguarding</p>	<p>If restrictions are implemented in our area, all local safeguarding partners will be vigilant and responsive to all safeguarding threats and ensure vulnerable students are safe.</p> <p>The Designated safeguarding lead will review the school policies to reflect any restrictions.</p> <p>All staff will be made aware of any changes.</p>

Vulnerable Children	Where attendance is limited, but vulnerable children should still be attending provision will be made for attendance. For those not in attendance, follow up with parents to explore the reason for absence, discuss any concerns and encourage the student to attend.
Communication	The academy will communicate plans for any imposed restrictions to all stakeholders.
